2. Date of event: Wednesday, 18 September 2019
3. No. of Beneficiary:  
150 students
4. The objective of the activity:

1. Title of Activity:

2. Date of event: Wednesday, 9 October 2019
3. No. of Beneficiary:  
100 students
4. Objective of activity:  
The main motto of conducting the session on Group Discussion is to introduce the first round of The Dais- Competition for first-year students.
5. Brief about activity:  
The session was conducted by Ms. Ankita Adhav and Ms. Sejal Patil. The session began at 5.30 pm. Generally, for the Group Discussions abstract topics are given, but as the session was for 1st-year students, some of them would be not able to present their points. To overcome this problem we came with an idea that we will provide them the hypothetical situations, which will ultimately improve their imagination and thinking ability, and helps everyone to present his or her points during the discussion.  
  
The Organising Committee members, Joint Directors, and Director were evaluating the groups and guiding them about their postures, gestures, and their contribution to a Group Discussion. This analysis helps the participants to improve their interpersonal skills.
6. Outcome of Activity:  
With this session on GD, the first-year students got familiar with the very important interpersonal skill-testing activity and were helped to improve and explore their potential.

2. Date of event: Thursday, 9 January 2020
3. No. of Beneficiary:  
40 students
4. Objective of activity:  
The session was on the Switch Debate, which benefitted students to think on all over aspects of the topic, enhancing their communication skills, presence of mind, refurnishing their soft skills.
5. Brief about activity:  
The weekly dais session took place on January 9, 2020, in the postgraduate hall(PG Hall) at sharp 5:15 P.M.  
  
The session started with a demo debate between the first year organizing committee members with an exciting topic. Many abstracts, as well as controversial topics, were chosen by the organizing committee, to enable the thinking capacity of students. The students were divided into groups of four, two people speaking in favor of the topic and others speaking out of favor. The second-year and third-year OC members were evaluating the participants to improve skills and overcome the difficulties.  
  
The session ended with an exciting note by a debate between the director, Mr. Sahil Patil, and other JDs. It was a great learning experience for all the participating students. The session ended around 6:30 P.M.

1. Title of Activity: Participation In Impulse'19
2. Date of event: Day 1: Sunday, 25 August 2019  
Day 2: Sunday, 01 September 2019
3. No. of Beneficiary:  
3 OC's of Dais Club achieved 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up Position at Impulse'19.
4. The objective of the activity:  
It was a mock of campus recruitment process designed to test, shape, and polish and improvise our soft skills with a tagline of "EXCEL THE EXCELLENCE".
5. Brief about activity:  
Impulse'19 is a University level Management event organized by SOFTA of Walchand College of Engineering, Sangli.  
  
The competition was of 2 days on 25th August 2019 and 1st September 2019. There were more than 400+ participants in the competition. A total of 8 members registered for the Competition from the Dais Club of our college. The Reporting time for the event on 25th August 2019 was 8 pm.  
  
The first day of the event consists of 3 rounds while the last 2 rounds of the event were taken on the second day. At the end of the first day, the competition was concluded at about 7 pm. Among the Dais club members, 3 people were qualified for the fourth round and were called for the second day.

3 of the Dais Club members were the FINALIST in the Competition out of 400+ participants. The OC members also got the experience of learning and competing outside the college campus.

## **The Dais Competition**

1. Title of Activity:  
The Dais Competition
2. Date of event: Saturday, 12 October 2019
3. No. of Beneficiary:  
82 students
4. The objective of the activity:  
The aim of organizing this the competition was to reduce the inferiority complex amongst the students and motivate them for impromptu thinking and presentation.
5. Brief about activity:  
The Dais Competition is one of the prominent events held by The Dais club every academic year. The competition was at an intra-college level competition. Two judges were invited to the competition. The first judge was Ms. Harshal Kajave who held a master's in business administration. She is a person with exceptional communication and human relation skills. She guided the participants through her experience. The second judge was Dr. Manisha Patil. She is the Head of the department of English at Yashwantrao Chavan Institute of Science at Satara.  
  
The competition was of one day in which there were three rounds. It started at 8 AM on 12th October 2019. There were two sub-rounds in the first round and the participants were supposed to be judged based on the overall score of these two sub rounds. The first one was the Aptitude test for 45 min.  
  
The second round of the competition was a perspective debate. In this round the participant was not alone in the debate, he/she was given a partner, and together they have to debate against the three groups arranged in the same manner.  
  
The third and the last round of the competition was The Big Picture which was a Surprise Round. The finalists were called upon the stage, 4 pictures were shown to the participants with a definite time interval and they have to create a meaningful story.  
  
Winners were decided by the judges.
6. Outcome of Activity:  
The participating students were guided and encouraged. They had a brilliant glimpse of the competitive world and learned the important skills required further. All the participants were given the certificate of participation.
